The sculpture alludes to the story of Zeus and his lover, first mentioned in the Iliad.

His pride drew the attention of the gods and he fell in love with his own image, turning into the namesake flower.

The gallery mostly focuses on photography and has hosted world-renowned artists, who tackle urgent social, political, environmental and humanist themes.

Plečnik added renaissance and baroque details, especially visible in the main courtyard.

Plečnik adorned the bridge with sculptures and pyramids, typical of his work, while the trees seamlessly connect the pass with its environs.

Žale is open to the public but remain a functioning cemetery, so be discreet if visiting.

The large church is stunning in its monumental simplicity, with a single nave that literally brings people together.

Due to unstable marsh ground where floods are frequent, Plečnik built the church on piles and elevated the sacred nave to the first floor - the elevated ground floor is used by the parish priest.

Plečnik had grand plans for the bridge at the market, but the project was completed only in 2010 according to a new but unfortunately subpar plans.

The iconic Ljubljana Bridge was constructed after the earthquake of 1895 and is one of the most visible examples of Vienna Secession infrastructure projects.

Long live all nations France Prešeren was the greatest Slovenian poet whose Romantic works exert influence to this day.

He is the author of the Slovenian national anthem, with the stanza extolling peace, brotherhood and self-determination.

The monument to Prešeren, the most well-known work by Ivan Zajc, was unveiled in 1905.
